

CITY COUNCIL

CITY OF PIEDMONT
OCTOBER 2ND, 2012
5:30 PM

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Pro-tem Billy Baker, Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Diane Studdard and Brent Morrison.

Mayor Young was absent from the meeting.

Mayor Pro-tem Baker declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Mary Bramblett made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

The bills totaling \$61,738.84 were then presented for consideration for payment. Kenny Kelley made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the bills were approved with one abstention from Ed Hanson.

Chief Tidwell gave the police report for the month August, 2012. Officers had 984 total contacts with the public, 40 misdemeanor arrests, 14 felony arrests, 2 drug arrests, 45 traffic citations, 78 incident reports, 3 accident reports and 65 criminal investigations. There were 104 ambulance calls dispatched in the police jurisdiction and 48 calls dispatched outside the police jurisdiction. The Piedmont Municipal Court collected 12,045.61 in court fines in the month of August.

In other business Mary Bramblett made the motion to allow City Clerk Michelle Franklin and Facilities Manager Craig Russell to get pricing information for equipment to be used for a women's workout at the Piedmont Civic Center. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

In council reports John Lawrence had no report.

Mary Bramblett had no report.

Ed Hanson had no report.

Kenny Kelley told the council that Ruby Stockdale would be opening the adult day care in a few weeks.

Diane Studdard said that she had been contacted by some citizens that wanted to be added to the abatement board.

Brent Morrison reminded everyone to go vote next Tuesday.

In the Mayor's comments Pro-tem Baker also reminded everyone to go and vote on Tuesday October 9th.

With no other business to come before the council Brent Morrison made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:07 pm.
