The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in a special session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Brian Young, Council Members, John Lawrence, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Eddie Baldwin, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

Mary Bramblett was absent from the meeting.

Mayor Young declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

The Mayor asked for a motion to accept the bids for the school renovations project for work to begin on Monday, November 29th, 2010. Billy Baker made the motion to accept the bids and to allow the Mayor or City Clerk to withdraw the bond money allocated to the Piedmont City School to pay the school, contractors and suppliers not to exceed \$4.9 million. Also the school will manage the bid process through the school system. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

The Mayor then asked for a motion to allow Commissioner Rudy Abbott to look into digging a lake at the sports complex. Brent Morrison made the motion to allow Commissioner Abbott to dig a lake with the understanding that the utility department head makes sure none of the utilities will be compromised in the digging process. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Brent Morrison made the motion to give the city employees a longevity incentive in the month of December. Billy Baker seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

With no other business to come before the council Brent Morrison made the motion to adjourn. Billy Baker seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 8:09 am.
