

CITY COUNCIL

CITY OF PIEDMONT
DECEMBER 20TH, 2011

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Brian Young, Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Diane Studdard and Brent Morrison.

Billy Baker was absent from the meeting.

Mayor Young declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Mary Bramblett made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$384,889.40 were then presented for consideration for payment. Kenny Kelley made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment with one abstention from Brent Morrison.

The Mayor asked for consideration of Resolution 2011-28 which is the holiday schedule for employees for 2012. Brent Morrison made the motion to adopt 2011-28. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and Resolution 2011-28 was adopted unanimously.

The Mayor then asked for consideration of Resolution 2011-29 which is to place a street light at 1420 Highway 278 West to be paid monthly to Alabama Power. Ed Hanson made the motion to pass Resolution 2011-29. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and Resolution 2011-29 passed unanimously.

In other business Brent Morrison made the motion to allocate the 20% match for the transportation bus through East Alabama Planning Commission. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

In council reports there were no reports except each council member wished everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

In the Mayor's comments the Mayor thanked everyone that worked on the downtown Christmas events and the Christmas parade.

With no other business to come before the council John Lawrence made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 5:50 pm.
