CITY OF PIEDMONT  
MARCH 6<sup>TH</sup>, 2012

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Brian Young, Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Diane Studdard, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

Mayor Young declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Billy Baker made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$224,041.03 were then presented for consideration for payment. Ed Hanson made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the bills were approved with two abstentions from Brent Morrison and Mary Bramblett.

The Mayor asked for consideration of Resolution 2012-06 which would vacate an alley located on South Center Ave. Brent Morrison made the motion to adopt Resolution 2012-06. Billy Baker seconded the motion and Resolution 2012-06 was adopted unanimously.

The Mayor appointed Mr. Walter Prater to be placed back on the Piedmont Housing Authority Board for another five year term. Brent Morrison made the motion to confirm the Mayor's appointment. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and Mr. Prater was placed back on the board with one abstention from John Lawrence.

In other business the Mayor asked for a motion to amend the budget to pay Calhoun County \$32,362.20 for paving in the City of Piedmont. Ed Hanson made the motion to amend the budget to show the adjustment. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

In council reports John Lawrence had no report.

Mary Bramblett had no report.

Ed Hanson said the AMEA meeting that he attended was very informative.

Kenny Kelley had no report.

Diane Studdard had no report.

Billy Baker had no report.

Brent Morrison asked the council to consider a city wide clean-up day.

In the Mayor's comments the Mayor said he enjoyed the Black History Month program at the Bethune Center. He also commented on the grand opening of the Piedmont High School Softball Field.

With no other business to come before the council Brent Morrison made the motion that the meeting be adjourned. Billy Baker seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 5:40 pm.
