CITY OF PIEDMONT
APRIL 5, 2011
5:30 PM

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Brian Young, Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Eddie Baldwin, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

Mayor Young declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation given by Rev. Roger Kennum and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Billy Baker made the motion to approve the minutes of the March 15, 2011 regular meeting. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously. Billy Baker also made the motion to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2011 special meeting. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.
