The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Brian Young, Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Eddie Baldwin, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

Mayor Young declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation given by Keith Word and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Billy Baker made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$328,611.66 were then presented for consideration for payment. Ed Hanson made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Brent Morrison seconded the motion and the bills were approved unanimously.

The Mayor asked for consideration of Resolution 2010-04 which lists vehicles to be sold as surplus on the gov deals website. Brent Morrison made the motion to accept Resolution 2010-04. Eddie Baldwin seconded the motion and Resolution 2010-04 was accepted unanimously.

In other business Brent Morrison informed the council that by law the school board appointment needed to be made in the month of April. He encouraged the council to decide on one person to vote on for the school board appointment.

Ed Hanson made the motion to purchase a new lawn mower for the Chief Ladiga Trail that would be paid for in thirds by the City of Piedmont, Cleburne County and Calhoun County. Billy Baker seconded the motion and the purchase was accepted unanimously.

In council reports John Lawrence had no report.

Mary Bramblett thanked Tessa Anderson for the great job that she did during the group meeting that was held at the library that many visitors from all over the state attended.

Ed Hanson had no report.

Kenny Kelley had no report.

Eddie Baldwin asked that the city show more participation in the library.

Billy Baker had no report.

Brent Morrison thanked the trail manager for painting over the graffiti that was located on the 200 by pass bridge next to the trail.

In the Mayor's comments, Mayor Young thanked Corey Pike for all the work he did at the ball fields getting them prepared for opening day. The Mayor also mentioned going to the ring ceremony for the Piedmont Bulldog State Champions. He reminded the council that opening day at the sports complex would be April 17<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 and the memorial dedication honoring Joe Lewis and Jerry Baker would also be at 8:30 a.m.

The Mayor informed the council that Sonya Motes, Austin Grissom and Allie Harper received the AMEA scholarships this year. He said that the Piedmont High School girl's golf team won a county tournament by thirty strokes.

The Mayor congratulated Chase Childers for winning the Bryant Jordan Scholarship Award.

With no other business to come before the council Brent Morrison made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:07 pm.
