

CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF PIEDMONT
JUNE 5, 2012

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Brian Young, Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

Diane Studdard was absent from the meeting.

Mayor Young called a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Billy Baker made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$357,525.62 were then presented for consideration for payment. Mary Bramblett made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. John Lawrence seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment with two abstentions from Ed Hanson and Kenny Kelley.

The Mayor then read a Proclamation for World Elder Abuse Awareness Day.

In other business Ed Hanson made the motion to purchase three air packs for the fire department with the only bid coming from NAFECO at \$7,395.00 per air pack. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

John Lawrence made the motion to finance two 2013 Ford Interceptor Utility vehicles for the police department to replace two of the older police vehicles. Each vehicle will be 24,843.00. Billy Baker seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Brent Morrison made the motion to cut three danger trees one in Piedmont Manor and three on Logan St. at \$3,500.00 for all trees. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Ruby Stockdale came back to discuss the possibility of opening an adult day care at the old hospital.

In council reports John Lawrence had no report.

Mary Bramblett had no report.

Ed Hanson told everyone about the new Dollar General Market opening in Piedmont.

Kenny Kelley had no report.

Billy Baker had no report.

Brent Morrison informed the council that he was trying to get some events set up for downtown like an antique tractor show and a knife and gun collection and a car show.

In the Mayor's comments the Mayor thanked Mary Bramblett for all of her work on trying to get business to come to the city and for also setting up the meeting with Gary Faulkner, Don Hooper and Representative Lindsey. He thanked Representative K.L. Brown for representing the city well.

He also congratulated the 2012 graduates from Piedmont High School.

With no other business to come before the council Billy Baker made the motion that the meeting be adjourned. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:16 pm.
