The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were, Mayor Brian Young, Council Members, Mary Bramblett, Kenny Kelley, Eddie Baldwin, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

John Lawrence and Ed Hanson was absent from the meeting.

Mayor Young declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation given by Keith Word and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Billy Baker made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$510,201.91 were then presented for consideration for payment. Eddie Baldwin made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the motion carried with one abstention from Brent Morrison.

Next on the agenda the Mayor recognized the children that live in public housing for making the honor roll for the previous school year. Each student received a medallion presented to them by Mayor Brian Young.

The Mayor called on Chief Tidwell to give the police report for the month of June 2010. During the month of June officers made a total of 979 contacts with the public. Officers made 50 misdemeanor arrests, 4 felony arrests and issued 150 citations. Of those arrests, 4 were for DUI and 7 were for drug offenses. The Municipal Court collected \$16,568.00 for the month of June.

In other business the Mayor asked for a motion to purchase two tracks of land. The first being the Morgan property on the corner of the 200 by pass and Piedmont Cut off Road and the Probst property that is adjacent to the Piedmont Sports Complex and to also authorize the Mayor to sign any necessary paperwork involving the purchase of the properties. Brent Morrison made the motion to purchase the two tracks of land and to give the Mayor the authority to sign the necessary paperwork. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

In council reports Mary Bramblett had no report.

Kenny Kelley had no report.

Eddie Baldwin had no report.

Billy Baker spoke about the DAV tribute to Mr. Travis Ivey and to all the WWII veterans.

Brent Morrison had no report.

In the Mayor's comments the Mayor congratulated the 12 and under girls for winning at state. He also spoke about the DAV tribute to Mr. Ivey and what an honor it was to take part in the event.

With no other business to come before the council Brent Morrison made the motion to adjourn. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:10 pm.
