

CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF PIEDMONT
JULY 5, 2011
5:30 PM

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Pro Tem Billy Baker Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Kenny Kelley, Eddie Baldwin, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

Mayor Young was absent from the meeting.

Mayor Pro Tem Baker declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation given by Keith Word and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Ed Hanson made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$51,312.72 were then presented for consideration for payment. Brent Morrison made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Eddie Baldwin seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment unanimously.

Mayor Pro Tem Baker asked for consideration of Resolution 2011-20 which is a resolution for the Safe Route to School project. Eddie Baldwin made the motion to accept Resolution 2011-20. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and Resolution 2011-20 was approved unanimously.

In other business Kenny Kelley made the motion to accept the low bid from NAFCO for five air packs at \$5,165.00 an air pack and also to allow Chief Trammell to negotiate the price as this was the only bid turned into the city. Brent Morrison seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Ed Hanson made the motion to follow the abatement guidelines to have property on Daily Street and the 500 block of fifth Ave. cut. Kenny Kelley seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

In council reports John Lawrence said that the league convention meeting that several council members attended was very informative.

Mary Bramblett thanked the electrical department for getting the power back on on 5th Ave. quickly.

Ed Hanson congratulated the eight and under boy's baseball team for making it to state. He also asked everyone to remember the family of Johnny Weaver a city employee that passed away.

Kenny Kelley also said that the league convention was very informative.

Eddie Baldwin congratulated Chief Jimmy Trammell for being recognized as the Number one firefighter in Calhoun County.

Brent Morrison gave the Chief Ladiga Trail report stating that there were 319 visitors on the trail in the month of June.

In Mayor's comments Mayor Pro Tem Baker thanked the street department for getting the flags put up in downtown for the 4th of July. He also echoed the other council members in saying how informative the league meeting was that they attended.

With no other business to come before the council John Lawrence made the motion to adjourn. Brent Morrison seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 5:48 pm.
