CITY OF PIEDMONT
SEPTEMBER 28TH, 2012
5:00 pm

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Brian Young, Council Members John Lawrence, Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Diane Studdard, Billy Baker and Brent Morrison.

Kenny Kelley was absent from the meeting.

Mayor Young declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Billy Baker made the motion to approve the minutes of the September 4th canvassing of the election results from the general election. Diane Studdard seconded the motion. Brent Morrison had no comment.

In the Mayor's comments the mayor reminded everyone of the regular council meeting October 2nd at 5:30. He also said that he was going to attend an Economic Development meeting to inquire about the EDC building a spec building in the City of Piedmont.
